for a new adventure each day in the beautiful outdoor setting of Little Cottonwood Canyon, high in the Wasatch Mountains. We explore the canyon environment through nature hikes, science experiments and other creative activities.

The majority of our days are spent outdoors. Each morning consists of camp games, free play and snacks in the fresh mountain air. Camp is then divided into groups for the remainder of the day's activities excluding BBQ and hot lunch days. Depending on age, groups consist of eight to twelve per counselor.

- Mondays: Science day
- Tuesdays*: Hiking day w/sack lunch
- Wednesdays: Sport day
- Thursdays: Team building
- Fridays: Arts & Craft day

Children have supervised swim time each day. Hot lunches will be served on Wednesdays and BBQ will be on Fridays.

We proudly offer a fun optional activity at a minimal charge: Snowbird's Alpine Slide! Optional activities such as the Alpine Slide begin on Wednesdays later in the season. Check with Camp Snowbird for more information.

Summer Hours

Camp Snowbird is open Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m.–5 p.m., June 7 through August 20, 2010. Camp Snowbird will be closed on July 2 and July 23, 2010.

Registration

Camp Snowbird is for children 4 to 12 years of age. All campers must preregister. The preregistration fee of \$25 per child includes a Camp Snowbird T-shirt.

All days must be pre-reserved or an additional drop-in fee will be charged. (This fee is necessary to provide adequate care for the children enrolled in Camp Snowbird, due to state ratios and regulations, as well as having an adequate amount of food for snacks and lunches.) No exceptions!

Location

Camp Snowbird is located on Level 1 of the Cliff Lodge, 25 miles southeast of downtown Salt Lake City in Little Cottonwood Canyon. The Cliff Lodge is just six miles from the mouth of the canyon. Take Snowbird Entry 4.



Rates

Rates include most activities, transportation to and from the UTA Park & Ride at the mouth of Little Cottonwood Canyon, lunch and snacks. Rates do not include the one-time \$25 per child registration fee and Alpine Slide or other optional activities.

If you are a season ticket holder and have unused vouchers from the 2009-2010 winter season, you can use one voucher toward the cost of one day of camp. Your pass number must be provided at registration.

Multiple days do not have to be consecutive, they can be any day of the summer 2010 season. Days must be reserved in advance or a \$50 drop-in fee will be charged. Changes can be made to your reservation over the phone at least 48 hours in advance (if space is available). All days purchased this summer must be used this summer. Sorry, No

Transportation

UTA bus transportation is available from the "Park & Ride" bus stop located at the mouth of Little Cottonwood Canyon. Counselors will accompany children up and down the canyon. Children must be signed in and out by an adult listed on the child's consent and release form.

Drop-off time: 7:30 a.m./Pick up time: 5:25 p.m. Late pickups will be charged accordingly.

Parent Reminders

All kids that join us for summer camp must be potty-trained. Children cannot join us if they wear sandals—this includes Teva sandals and the like. Please make sure your children wear or carry regular shoes—NO open toes or heels!

No electronic devices are allowed at camp—this includes cell phones, CD and MP3 players, Game Boys, etc.

Please make sure to pack a water bottle for each child in your family every day.* Water is essential at Camp Snowbird due to physical exertion and the altitude.

We swim every day. Swim time does not include instruction. If your child cannot swim, please let us know. He or she will still go to the pool with us and can play in the water on the pool steps. Please provide some type of flotation if your child does not swim; such as a life vest.

Please pack a sweatshirt or jacket every day as the weather in the mountains is unpredictable!



** Parents: please be advised on Tuesdays water bottles and backpacks are VERY important. The hiking at Snowbird is somewhat moderate to extreme and water is essential. Hikes are geared for appropriate age levels. Please have your child come prepared on these days.*
