BLACK	Skiers; you can make carved, short turns on black runs and you seek out off-trail conditions. Riders; you can link turns on black runs, seek out off-trail conditions, may be doing jumps & tricks.
BLACK/BLACK	Skiers; you ski on & off trail conditions, steep and narrow terrain, with skill & confidence. Riders; you confidently ride on & off trail conditions, steep & narrow terrain, & freestyle moves.

WAIVER OF CLAIMS/RELEASE/AND INDEMNIFICATION

Mountain School Camps

I, the undersigned, in consideration of Snowbird Corporation providing access to its property for my participation in a Mountain School Camp ("Camp"), the undersigned hereby expressly acknowledges, accepts and assumes all risk of personal injury, including death and property damage to equipment associated with this camp. I agree not to operate outside of the agreed-to format for this camp and will at no time become inverted during this camp.

I understand that the sport of skiing/riding can be dangerous and that my actions are subject to the inherent risk of the activity. Inherent risk means those dangers or conditions which are an integral part of the sport of skiing, snowboarding, and winter activities, including, but not limited to: changing weather conditions, variations and steepness in terrain, snow or ice conditions; surface or subsurface conditions such as bare spots, forest growth, rocks, stumps, impact with lift towers, and other structures and their components whether man-made or natural; slick or uneven walking surface; loading and unloading ski lifts; collisions with other skier/riders; and skier/rider's failure to ski or jump within the skier/rider's own ability. I also understand that if I am involved in a collision with another skier/rider, I am responsible, under the law, to stop and render any reasonable assistance. Such assistance may include warding off other skier/riders while waiting for aid or contacting resort personnel or ski patrol. Any skier/rider involved in a collision must present identification or supply his name and address to the ski patrol or injured skier/rider.

In consideration for participation in a Mountain School Camp at Snowbird and use of Snowbird Ski and Summer Resort facilities, and as a condition precedent thereto, **I hereby waive any and all claims against Snowbird arising out of Snowbird's negligence or the negligence of any of its agents or employees, and hereby release Snowbird, its affiliates, officers, directors, agents and employees for any and all liability or damages arising out of the camp including, without limitation, claims for injury, liability or damages arising out of the negligence of Snowbird and its agents, officers, directors and employees.** In the event that a claim or legal action for injuries arising out of the event is made against Snowbird, I agree to indemnify and hold Snowbird harmless from and against all such claims and actions and agree to reimburse Snowbird for any costs, attorneys' fees, judgments, or settlement amounts paid by Snowbird in relation to said claims or actions. **This agreement to indemnify Snowbird includes all claims and legal actions, even if the injuries, damages or liability arise out of or are alleged to have arisen out of the sole or comparative negligence of Snowbird. I agree that any legal action involving interpretation of this document and/or alleging liability against Snowbird, regardless of the legal theory under which the action is brought, shall only be filed in Utah and shall be governed by Utah law.**

If any portion of this Snowbird Mountain School Release and Acknowledgment of Risk document is deemed unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, then all remaining portions remain enforceable and valid.
